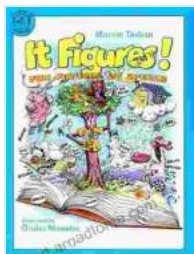
6 Figures of Speech

Alliteration — the occurrence of the same consonant letter or sound at the beginning of adjacent or closely connected words.
• Carly cooked a casserole • Will wanted warm weather • Boston baked beans
- METAPHOR**
Metaphor — a comparison between two things that aren't alike but do have something in common.
• Life is a journey • Laughter is the best medicine • His words are wisdom • Her eyes were ice
- PERSONIFICATION**
Personification — giving human qualities to animals, inanimate objects, or abstract notions.
• The hyena laughed • The fog crept in • The wind howled • The snowflakes danced
- ONOMATOPOEIA**
Onomatopoeia — a word that sounds like what it is describing.
• Click • Meow • Buzz • Drizzle • Whoosh • Splat

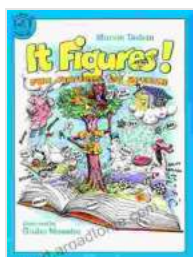

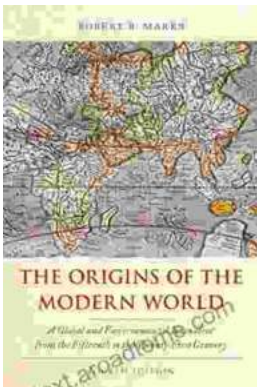
