There are four natural lakes in Maryland. All existing lakes have been made artificially by damming rivers. The largest of these, Deep Creek Lake, is 12 miles (19 km) long. It covers 3,900 (11,578 hectares), and it has 65 miles (105 km) of shoreline. Deep Creek Lake is a popular place to swim and fish for bass, pike, and trout.

Many Marylanders enjoy all the water that surrounds them. Some like to sail boats in the bay. Others prefer to water-ski. Sport fishing is popular in the Atlantic Ocean, and many people enjoy catching crabs in the bay and rivers.

Diverse Geography

Maryland's varied landscape is divided into three main regions. The eastern part—which is split by the Chesapeake Bay—is called the Atlantic Coastal Plain. This region includes the Eastern Shore—east of the bay—as well as part of the Western Shore. The area is dotted with marshes and swamps. Much of the fertile land is used for growing crops and raising chickens. The Atlantic Coastal Plain is home to Baltimore, Maryland's largest city. Ocean City, a popular beach town, is also located there. Only about seven thousand residents live in Ocean City year-round, but millions of tourists visit each summer.

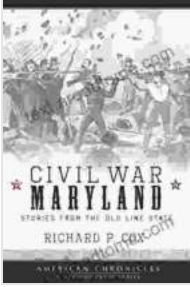


Maryland borders Delaware, Pennsylvania, West Virginia, and Washington, DC.
