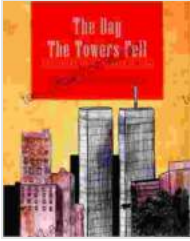
A Day that Shocked the World

Remembrance and Legacy

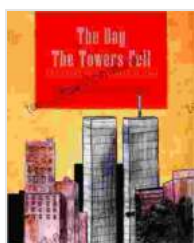
The anniversary of September 11 is now a day of remembrance and reflection. People around the world gather at memorials, hold candlelight vigils, and offer prayers for the victims and their families.
